



Policy Recommendations*

- 1. Minimum Reserve Storage Requirements SUPPORT
 - a. Also recommend **foreign export data analysis** to evaluate if a portion of exported fuel products can be stored and meet CA standards, helping to smooth out supply & avoid price spikes
- 2. Spot Market Reporting & Transparency SUPPORT
- 3. Price-gouging Penalty with robust cost-benefit & risk assessment SUPPORT

Continue to Explore

- 4. Cost-of-Service, Gas Price Stabilization Fund, Retail Margin Management
 - a. Add refiner-retail management policy options (CDFTA)

Additional EJ Policy Recommendations

- Safeguards for Community Safety: Require milestone reductions in refinery fuel production and total refinery emission reductions that meet in-state demand
 - 2. Direct Payments to Income-Qualified Consumers: Increase economically vulnerable consumers' limited ability to pay for fuel and/or other modes of transit
